Dear Hon Mauldin,

My name is Jeremy James Davis. I have committed no crime. I am writing you because I have recently been presented with (and subsequently reviewed) a redacted grand jury indictment that implicates me as an alleged co-conspirator to the following charges:

- 18 U.S.C. – 1962(d)
- 18 U.S.C. – 1962(c)
- 18 U.S.C. – 371
- 18 U.S.C. 2423(a)
- 18 U.S.C. – 2423(b)
- 18 U.S.C. – 3283
- 18 U.S.C. – 2
- 31 U.S.C. – 5324
- 18 U.S.C. – 2253 (a)
- 18 U.S.C. – 2253 (o)

In addition to these charges I have been informed that there are other charges that may be outlined in a sealed version of this indictment, as well as corresponding state charges that were filed against Malachi Z. York, aka Dwight D. York. I am not in possession of either one of those indictments, so I cannot identify the charges specifically.

I am writing you because the indictment very clearly implicates me as an alleged co-conspirator and I would like to know what steps need to be taken so that I may answer these allegations (which are false accusations) and be extended my right to due process. As it stands now I am a victim of severe character defamation and slander. I share this plight with many others, including Dr. Malachi Z. York.

In spite of identifying myself as one of the alleged (unindicted) “unidentified co-conspirators” to these charges I have been turned away from the authorities and have been denied my right to due process. I have attempted to turn myself in (along with another alleged co-conspirator) to the Athens Police and the Athens-Clarke County Sheriff’s Office (by way of the Athens-Clarke County Jail). In the case of the former I was told that I could not be detained because there was no warrant issued for my arrest, and in the latter I was told that the detective’s “workload” was too extensive and I should go to the State Attorney General’s office.

Your being my local District Attorney, I am seeking your advice and guidance on this most pressing matter. I am certain that if an individual (particularly a black man) was implicated as being an alleged co-conspirator for murder, (or even the kidnapping of the UGA mascot) that they would have been detained. It seems that there exists a double standard in the

justice system today. "Due Process" is readily utilized when it is in the interest of the system attempting to prove someone's guilt; however it does not seem to even exist in the interest of an individual attempting to prove his/her own innocence.

I have been implicated and falsely accused of some of the most heinous crimes imaginable. I come forward boldly to answer those charges and I am turned away. In the meanwhile I am a victim of slander and character assassination and character defamation; and an equally innocent man rots underneath a jail for 135 years for allegedly conspiring with apparently no one.

Out of respect for your office I do not want to bombard you with a bunch of emotionally charged letters addressing the same issue. With that in mind I have also written this letter on behalf of several others who have also very implicitly been targeted in this indictment as alleged co-conspirators. We implore you to work within the boundaries and constraints of your authority to properly guide us on the path to seeing our day(s) in court to defend ourselves against these injurious accusations.
